Fairy Tales before the Page

You just read the fairy tale "Cinderlad." People used to share iairy tales orally. Before the stories were written down, storytellers used memory tricks.

One memory trick in fairy tales is story structure, which is a kind of pattern. Many fairy tales share similar patterns. First, a character has a problem. Then, a character receives help. Last, the character solves the problem. "Cinderlad" has this pattern.

Another feature is **repetition**. In fairy tales, repetition often comes in threes. For example, Cinderlad goes to the meadow three times. He has three suits of armor. He scales the mountain three times.

Story structure and repetition have helped people remember tales for hundreds of years. Because of this, we can still tell these stories today!


