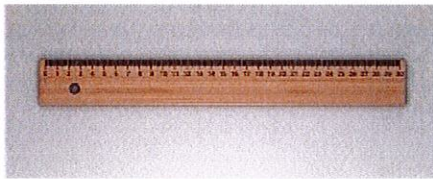

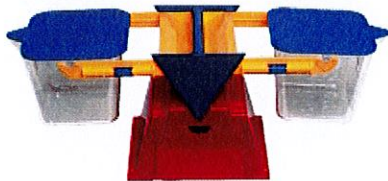

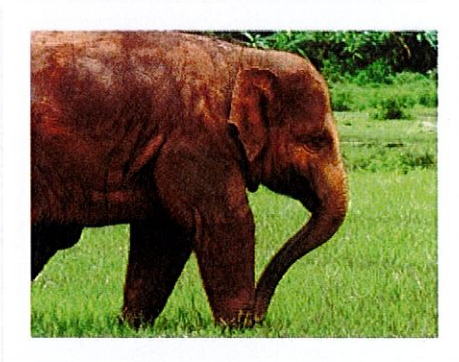

Essential Question Why do people protect animal habitats?

Turtle Beach

A few months ago, I spent the day at the beach with my sister, Carmen. She is a volunteer who works to conserve sea turtles. She finds turtle nests and protects them from being disturbed.

"Turtles have always laid their eggs on the beach, but now there are lots of buildings and people here," she told me. "We protect their eggs to help turtles survive. We'll start by looking for turtle tracks."



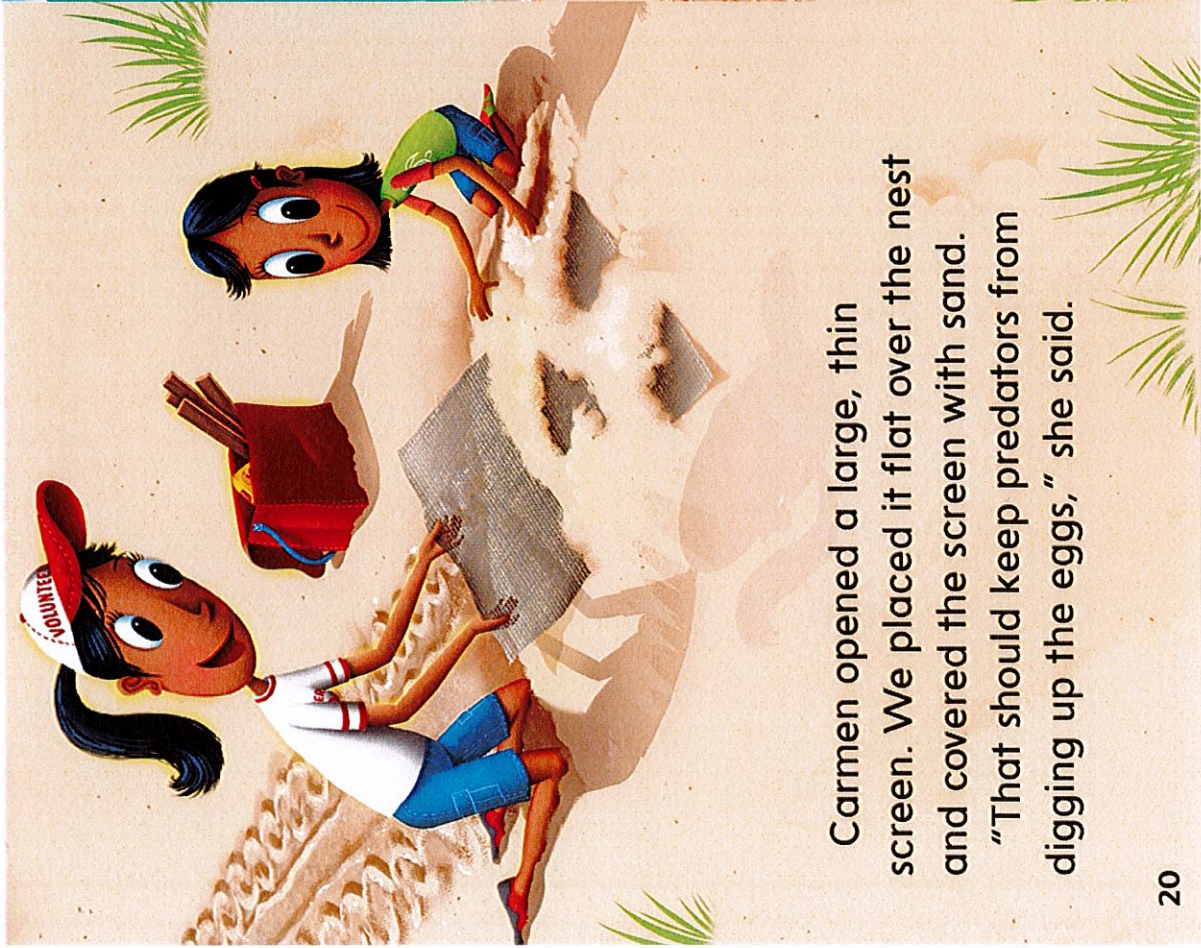
I found the first set of tracks. They led to a pile of sand. "Great work, Mia!" exclaimed Carmen. "You found a turtle nest!"

We studied the tracks. They went straight up the beach from the ocean.

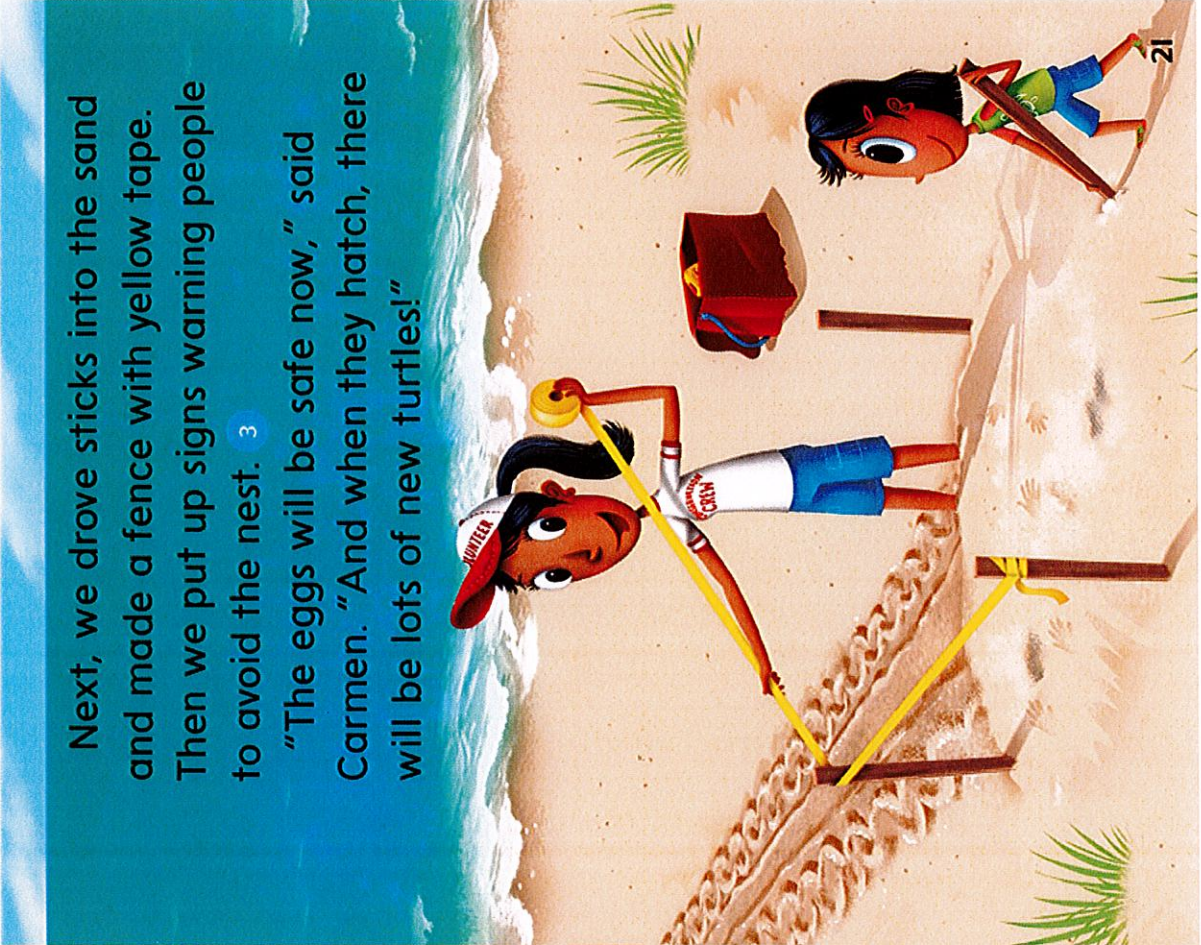
Carmen measured the tracks. I drew a diagram of them and took some photos.

"This will help us learn more about turtles," said Carmen. "Now it's our responsibility to protect the nest." She took a special kit out of her bag.





Carmen opened a large, thin screen. We placed it flat over the nest and covered the screen with sand. "That should keep predators from digging up the eggs," she said.

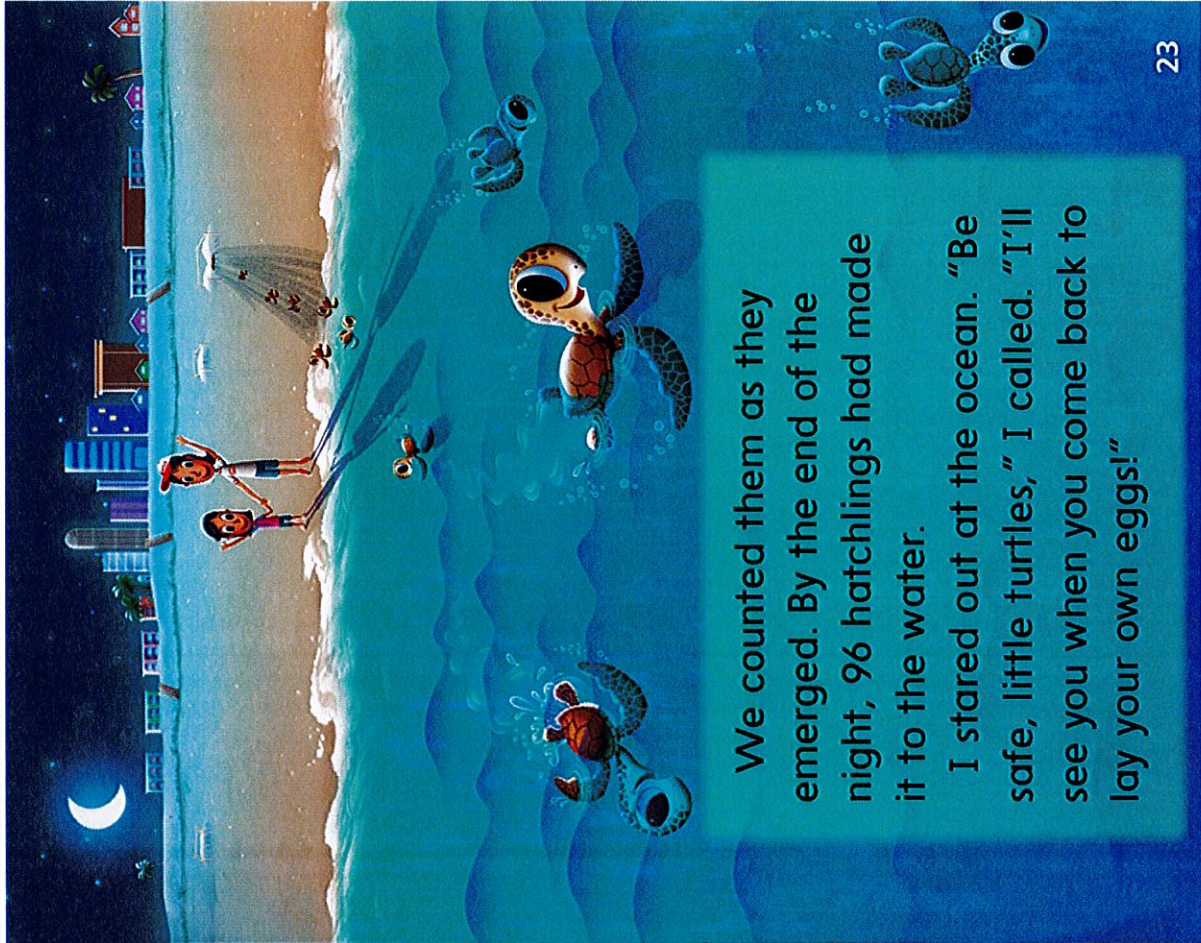


Next, we drove sticks into the sand and made a fence with yellow tape. Then we put up signs warning people to avoid the nest. ³

"The eggs will be safe now," said Carmen. "And when they hatch, there will be lots of new turtles!"

Two months later, we sat on the beach at night near the nest. We had waited there for a few hours each night for weeks. Suddenly, the sand on the nest started to sink. A tiny, perfect turtle dug its way out of the sand.

Soon the sand was crawling with hatchlings marching to the ocean. 4



We counted them as they emerged. By the end of the night, 96 hatchlings had made it to the water.

I stared out at the ocean. "Be safe, little turtles," I called. "I'll see you when you come back to lay your own eggs!"
