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To make lemonade, you need lemons, sugar, and water. First, you squeeze the lemons. Pour the juice into a glass. Next, you add water. Fill the glass to near the top. Then you put sugar in the glass. Stir with a spoon until you can't see the sugar. Now you have lemonade!



When you make lemonade, you make changes. Lemon juice and sugar change in the water. They dissolve in the water. To dissolve means to mix with a liquid and become part of it. The lemon juice and the sugar become part of the water. They are mixed together. You cannot tell which part is water, juice, or sugar. It all looks the same. The water, juice, and sugar are changed.

Water, juice, and sugar are types of matter. Matter is anything that takes up space and has mass. Matter is made of <u>atoms</u>. All atoms move.

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
Some atoms move very slowly. They are close together. These atoms make up solids. Sugar is a solid.



Some atoms move a little more.


These atoms are farther apart. They make up liquids. Water is a liquid.

Some atoms move very fast. They spread far apart. They make up gas. Steam is a gas.





Solid, liquid, and gas are called <u>states of matter</u>. Things can change states. A solid can become liquid by heating it up. If you heat up ice, it becomes water. If you heat up water, it becomes steam. Adding heat is one way to change the state of matter.



Some solids dissolve in a liquid. This is another way to change a solid to a liquid.


Sugar dissolves in water. The sugar was solid. When it was put in water, it became a liquid. It changed state from solid to liquid.

Melting ice and making lemonade are types of change. Ice changes to water. Water can also change to ice. If you freeze water, the atoms slow down. They sit very close together and become solid. Water changes back to ice.










Water changes to ice. Ice changes back to water. These are <u>reversible changes</u>. "Reverse" means "to go back." A reversible change is a change that can go back. It can change back to the way it used to be.

Making lemonade is also a reversible change. If you heat lemonade, the water in it will boil. Water changes to steam. It evaporates, or turns into a gas. The sugar and lemon juice are left behind. They are not dissolved in the water anymore. If you add water again, it will turn back to lemonade. This is a reversible change.


Sometimes adding heat makes different changes. Cake batter is in the liquid state. You can heat up the batter. The cake batter does not turn to steam. Instead, the cake bakes. It turns solid and hard.








Is this a reversible action? Can you turn a baked cake into cake batter? Can a solid cake become liquid again? No. This is not a reversible change. It is an irreversible change. The irmeans "not." An <u>irreversible change</u> cannot be changed back. It cannot be undone.
